Fabergé and the Danish royal family

De fleste genstande af Fabergé, som findes i den danske kongefamilie i dag, kan spores tilbage til to kvinder, der har glædet familiemedlemmer med gaver købt hos Fabergé og selv har modtaget sådanne gaver, der siden er gået i arv.

Most of the Fabergé artefacts in the possession of Danish royal family today can be traced back to two women, who delighted members of the family with gifts purchased from Fabergé, and who received similar gifts themselves, which were later passed on.

Kristine Designet af Nikolaj (1847-1918) var 1881 i Danmark og blev anset for Christian IX. Henset til kongen af Danmark.
Anastasia Mikhalovna (1860-1918) blev gift med kongen.

Empress Maria Feodorovna (1828-1908) was born in Denmark and became a princess, when her father, Christian IX, was crowned King of Denmark.
Alexandra Mikhalovna (1860-1918) married the king.
